2.	Matthew 22:36 Master, which is the great commandment in the law?
	Deuteronomy 6:5 And thou shalt the LORD thy God with all thine heart, and with all thy soul, and with all thy might.
4.	Matthew 22:38, 39 This is the first and great commandment. And the second is like unto it, Thou shalt thy neighbor as thyself.
5.	Matthew 22:40 On these two commandments hang the law and the prophets.

12.	The "P" Word: Love is the <u>Principle</u> of giving what is needed most.
13.	John 14:15 ye love me, keep my commandments.
14.	Deuteronomy 6:24 And the LORD commanded us to do all these statutes, to fear the LORD our God, <u>for our good</u> always, that he might preserve us alive, as it is at this day.
15.	Romans 13:10 Love worketh no ill to his neighbour: therefore love is the fulfilling of the
16.	Romans 7:12 Wherefore the law is holy, and the commandment holy, and just, and good.

Deuteronomy 31:24-26) 19. **Colossians 2:16** Let no man therefore judge you in meat [offerings], or in drink [offerings], or in respect of an holyday[s], or of the new moon [festivals], or of the [ceremonial] Sabbath days: [like the feast of trumpets or the Passover, etc.] (Sacrifices, and meat and drink offerings were offered on these annual feast days, not the weekly Sabbaths - Leviticus 23:37, 38; Hebrews 9:9, 10) 20. **Colossians 2:17** [The laws] Which are a ______ of things to come; ... (The laws concerning sacrifices were only a "shadow of good things to come." Hebrews 10:1) 21. **Matthew 5:18** For verily I say unto you, Till heaven and earth pass, one jot or one tittle shall in no wise pass from the law, till all be _____ 22. **Romans 8:4** That the righteousness of the <u>law</u> might be <u>fulfilled</u> _____, who walk not after the flesh, but after the Spirit. 23. **Galatians 3:13** Christ hath redeemed us from the curse of the law, ... 24. **Romans 7:7 NKJ** What shall we say then? Is the law sin? Certainly not! On the contrary, I would not have known sin except through the law. For I would not have known covetousness unless the law had said, "You shall not covet." 25. **1 Timothy 1:8** But we know that the law is good, if a man use it ______; 26. **John 15:10** If ye keep my commandments, ye shall abide in my love; even as I have kept my Father's commandments, and abide in his love. 27. **Matthew 5:44** But I say unto you, ______ your enemies, <u>bless</u> them that curse you, do good to them that hate you, and pray for them which despitefully use you, and persecute you; 28. **Matthew 5:45** That ye may be the children of your Father which is in heaven: for he maketh his sun to rise on the evil and on the good, and sendeth rain on the just and on the unjust. 29. **Matthew 5:48** Be ye therefore _____, even as your Father which is in heaven is perfect. 30. **2 Peter 1:3 NKJ** His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue.

- 31. **Hebrews 10:16** This is the covenant that I will make with them after those days, saith the Lord, I will put my laws into their hearts, and in their minds will I write them
- 32. **John 13:35** By this shall all men know that ye are my disciples, if ye have _____ one to another.

- 1. God loved the world so much that He gave His only Son. (John 3:16¹; 1 John 4:16⁷; 4:19¹¹)
- 2. The love of God and Jesus was not just a sappy, sentimental emotion. The love that Christ revealed, that He lived is a principle. ¹²The principle of giving what is needed most regardless of how we feel.
- 3. Jesus said the two most fundamental commandments are the two that express the "love" component most clearly:
 - 1. "Thou shall love the LORD thy God with all thine heart,"
 - 2. "Thou shalt love thy neighbor as thyself."

(Matthew 22:37-40^{4, 5}; Deuteronomy 6:5³; Leviticus 19:18)

- 4. When this love becomes a principle¹² in our hearts too, we will be happy to keep God's moral law. Because "love is the fulfilling of the law." (Romans 13:10¹⁵; 1 Corinthians 13:4-8; Ephesians 5:2⁹; John 13:34³³)
- 5. These two words keep coming together, LOVE and COMMANDMENTS. God showed His LOVE for us by sending His son to die for us. (1 John 4:10) Then He says, "If you LOVE Me, keep my COMMANDMENTS." (John 14:15; 15:10; 1 John 5:3; 2:4; Deuteronomy 6:24; Romans 3:31; 7:7; 8:4)
- 6. Jesus did not come to merely call us righteous. He came to make us righteous. (2 Corinthians 5:17; Hebrews $10:16^{30}$; John 3:5, 6; Romans $8:4^{22}$; John $13:35^{31}$; Matthew 5:16, 17^{32})
- 7. In our previous Bible study we learned that "Salvation is saying yes to the Lord in all our known choices." Accepting God's loves for us, and sharing that love with others are the most important places to say "YES" to our God. (Matthew 22:37-39⁴; 1 John 4:19)
