- 1. One of the clearest evidences of God's divinity is prophecy, His ability to know the end from the beginning. (Isaiah 46:9, 10¹)
- 2. Jesus used the prophecy of Daniel 8 as an unerring guide for His own life. It predicted the very year He (the Messiah) would be anointed (AD 27) and the very time He was to die (AD 31). (Daniel 9:25⁷, 26⁸; Matthew 28:18¹¹)
- 3. Jesus encouraged His followers to read and understand the prophecies of Daniel. The prophecy in chapter 8 leads us to the date for the cleansing of the sanctuary or the beginning of God's investigative judgment (1844). (Daniel 8:14³; 7:9¹⁴)
- 4. Since Jesus as well as many Bible writers prophesied of this event, we can be certain that a time is coming when all our words, thoughts, and actions will come into judgment. (Matthew 12:36; John 9:39¹²; 5:22; Luke 11:32; Revelation 14:6, 7¹⁶; Ecclesiastes 12:14; Daniel 7:9¹⁴; Malachi 3:5; Romans 2:5, 6)
- 5. With every act and thought of our life examined so closely we have only one hope–that Christ will plead His blood in our behalf. (2 Corinthians 5:10; Hebrews 8:1, 2; 7:24, 25)
- 6. One of the final prophetic messages Jesus said would go to the world was "the hour of His judgment is come". We are now in that judgment hour. (Revelation 14:6, 7)

Choices: Just as Jesus knew from Daniel's prophecy that the time was at hand for Him to die, we can know from the same prophecy that the judgment has now started. Do you want to ask Christ to be your Hight Priest in the heavenly sanctuary? (Matthew 26:18¹¹; Revelation 14:7¹⁶; Hebrews 4:14-16)
