1. **Matthew 26:64 RSV** "... I tell you, hereafter you will see the Son of man seated at the right hand of Power, and \_\_\_\_\_ on the clouds of heaven."
2. **John 14:2, 3** In my Father's house are many mansions: if it were not so, I would have told you. I go to prepare a place for you. And if I go and prepare a place for you, I will \_\_\_\_\_ again, and receive you unto myself; that where I am, there ye may be also.

19. **Jeremiah 4:23-26** I beheld the earth ... it was without form, and \_\_\_\_\_; and the heavens, ... had no light. ... the mountains ... trembled, and all the hills moved lightly. I beheld, and, lo, there was no man, ... and all the cities were broken down at the presence of the LORD, and by his fierce anger.
20. **Revelation 20:1, 2** And I saw an angel come down from heaven ... And he laid hold on the dragon, that old serpent, which is the Devil, and \_\_\_\_\_, and bound him a thousand years.

  5. Satan and his rebellious angels get 1,000 years to contemplate the results of what they have done. (Revelation 20:1, 2<sup>20</sup>, 3)
  6. During the 1,000 years, God takes time so that every question raised by sin and Satan's rebellion is fully answered before the final administration of judgment. (Revelation 15:2-4)
  7. Because of God's fairness and thoroughness in dealing with the questions and heartaches which sin has raised, affliction will never rise up again! (Nahum 1:9)
