1. The 4 gospels, Matthew, Mark, Luke, and John, tell of many, many appearances by intelligent beings from beyond our earth. Beings that care deeply and have influenced what has happened here! (See Angels in Summary p. 3)
2. By faith Abraham prophesied that God would provide Himself a lamb. Then God sent an angel to point it out to Abraham. At His birth, 1,800 years later, God sent angels to point to Jesus as the Lamb which He had provided to be our Savior. (Genesis 22:8¹, 11-14; Matthew 1:20, 21^{8,9}; Luke 2:10-12¹²⁻¹⁴; John 1:29-34)
3. There are alien beings here on earth that are not friendly to us. The Bible tells us there was war in heaven. Satan and his army were once angelic beings who rebelled and were cast out of heaven! (Revelation 12:7-9; Isaiah 14:12-15; Luke 10:18¹⁷; Luke 4:33-35^{19,20}; Ephesians 6:11, 12; Ezekiel 28:12-19)
4. The story of Jesus' life "squares up" with many witnesses who did not have a vested interest in the story. And also with many more witnesses who were willing to give up their lives rather than deny what they had seen, heard, and experienced! (Luke 2:8-17^{12,13}; 1 Corinthians 15:4-8; 1 John 1:1-4; 2 Peter 1:16-18)
5. Just as in Jesus' time, Satan and his angels still try to disguise themselves as ministers of truth to deceive as many as they can. (2 Corinthians 11:14, 15^{21,22}; 1 Peter 5:8, 9)
6. Jesus' victory spelled Satan's defeat. Satan knows that he has but a short time. When Jesus returns the sky will be filled with God's angelic armies, come to take home His redeemed! (Revelation 12:10-12; Matthew 28:18; 24:30, 31; 1 Corinthians 15:57)
7. We are not alone in this universe. Like Jesus, we too can enter into partnership with heavenly beings. God, His Son, the Holy Spirit, and the angels are working to restore us to God's "family in heaven and earth." (Hebrews 1:14; Romans 8:31; 1 Corinthians 15:57; Ephesians 4:15)

7. **Luke 1:31** And, behold, thou shalt conceive in thy womb, and bring forth a son, and shalt call his name JESUS.
8. **Matthew 1:20** ... Joseph, thou son of David, fear not to take unto thee Mary thy wife: for that which is conceived in her is of the Holy Ghost.
9. **Matthew 1:21** ... thou shalt call his name _____: for he shall save his people from their sins.
10. **Matthew 2:13** ... take the young child and his mother, and flee into Egypt, and be thou there until I bring thee word: for Herod will seek the young child to destroy him.

11. **Matthew 2:20** . . . Arise, and take the young child and his mother, and go into the land of Israel: for they are dead which sought the young child's life.

19. **Luke 4:33, 34** . . . [The man] cried out with a loud voice, saying, Let us alone; what have we to do with thee, thou Jesus of Nazareth. Art thou come to destroy _____? I know thee who thou art; the Holy One of God.
20. **Luke 4:35** And Jesus rebuked him, saying, Hold thy peace, and come out of him. And when the _____ had thrown him in the midst, he came out . . .
21. **2 Corinthians 11:14** And no marvel; for Satan himself is transformed into an _____ of light.
22. **2 Corinthians 11:15** niv It is not surprising, then, if his servants masquerade as servants (or ministers) of righteousness.
