- 1. We are loved, and that is why Jesus came to save us. (Luke 19:10¹)
- 2. The Bible teaches that "all have sinned" and therefore have need of a Savior. Like the tax collector, we too must say YES to God's spiritual evaluation and ask for forgiveness. Then we too will have His justification given to us. (Romans 3:23²; Psalm 14:3³; Luke 18:14⁵)
- 3. Salvation is more than a church or some doctrines. Salvation is a person, Jesus, and what He did and is doing for everyone, just like Simeon said. (Luke 2:30⁷; John 5:39; 17:3⁹)
- 4. When I ask Jesus for forgiveness, the next thing I need to accept (say YES to) is that He has forgiven me. "If we confess our sins, he is faithful and just to forgive us our sins, and to cleanse us from all unrighteousness." (1 John 1:9; 3:20; Romans 8:31)
- 5. Once I have been 'justified' (declared righteous), the next step is being 'sanctified' (or being made righteous). Jesus said this happens through the embraced truths of His word. Therefore, we are to say YES to the truths in the Bible as we learn them. (John 17:17¹⁰; John 5:39; 1 Peter 1:23; 2 Peter 3:18)
- True *belief* is not just something we give a mental assent to, it is also something we do. (Matthew 7:21; 19:21¹⁵; John 14:15; Mark 16:16²⁴; James 2:18, 19; Hebrews 11:7)
- 7. It is our committed and growing relationship with Jesus that gives us the power to obey Him. (John 15:4, 5; Colossians 1:27; John 17:21-23)
- Though death to self at first appears hard, as we continue to say "Yes" to God, sanctification becomes easier and easier. (Luke 9:23, 24²⁷; Matthew 6:33²⁶; Philippians 2:13³⁰)
- **Choices:** For Heaven to be safe for everyone who will live there, everyone will have to be saying YES to God. So I choose to say YES with all my known choices starting now. (Revelation 21:27³¹)
