1.	Today, as in Eden of old, we are offered two choices. 1) to believe God who said you, "shall surely die" (Genesis 2:17) or 2) believe Satan, the father of lies (John 8:44), who said, "you will <i>not</i> surely die" (Genesis 3:4).
2.	According to Genesis 2:7 the formula for human life is Body (dust) + Breath (spirit) = Life (soul). Ecclesiastes 12:7 shows this same equation in reverse, Body (dust) - Breath (spirit) = Death (no soul).
3.	The conclusion that we have an immortal soul that lives on and on, a spirit consciousness that survives the grave is not supported by Moses (Genesis 2:7, Job 14:21), Solomon (Ecclesiastes 12:7), David (Psalm 89:48; Psalm 115:17), or Ezekiel (Ezekiel 18:4, 20).
4.	Under inspiration both Solomon and David make it clear that when someone is dead they know <i>nothing</i> (Ecclesiastes 9:5; Psalm 115:17).
5.	In the Bible death is referred to as sleep 66 times in 17 books. Even Jesus lived out this understanding in the story of Lazarus (John 11:11-13, 25, 39, 43, 44).
6.	Though we do not have an immortal soul, there is eternal life awaiting those who accept Jesus and are saved

John 11:3, 4, 11, 12, 14 Lord, he who thou lovest is sick. ...This sickness is not unto death. Our friend Lazarus \_\_\_\_\_\_; but I go, that I may awake him out of sleep. Then said his disciples, Lord, if he sleep, he shall do well. Then said Jesus unto them plainly, Lazarus is dead. (Read the entire account in John 11:1-44.)

**John 11:43, 44** ...he cried with a loud voice, Lazarus, come forth. And he that was dead came forth, bound hand and foot with graveclothes: and his face was bound about with a napkin. Jesus saith unto them, Loose him, and let him go.

**Job 14:12, 21** So a man lies down and does not rise. Till the heavens are \_\_\_\_\_ more, they will not awake nor be roused out of their sleep. His sons come to honor, and he does not know it; they are brought low, and he does not perceive it.
