1 Prophetic Day = 1 Literal Year
69 prophetic weeks x 7 days = 483 prophetic days or literal years. 457 BC minus 483 literal years (prophetic days) brings us to 27 AD. The very year Iesus was anointed as Messiah.

- **Daniel 9:27** Adds one more prophetic week or 7 literal years.
- **Daniel 9:24** Seventy weeks are determined upon thy people and upon the holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sins, and to make reconciliation for iniquity, and to bring in everlasting righteousness, and to seal up the vision and prophecy, and to anoint the Most Holy.
