- 1. God's original desire for everyone was that we would all be perfectly healthy and happy. (Genesis 1:1⁴, 31⁵; Jeremiah 29:11)
- 2. Man's choice to sin or rebel against God's perfect plan for our happiness, has resulted in negative consequences. Yet Jesus' teaching still points us back to the beginning as His ideal for our happiness. (Matthew 19:8²; Mark 10:6⁹; Genesis 1:31⁵)
- 3. Since Jesus is our creator, He left in His word the guidelines for a happy marriage. They are purity, trust, commitment, forgiveness, equality, and putting God first. (John 1:1-4⁷; Matthew 5:28¹⁰; 1 Corinthians 6:9, 10¹¹; Proverbs 31:11¹²; Mark 10:6-8, 11, 12¹³; Ephesians 4:32¹⁴; Matthew 6:12¹⁵; 2 Corinthians 6:14¹⁶; Amos 3:3¹⁷; Matthew 6:33¹⁸)
- 4. Though God's guidelines run counter to the culture of today, they lead us into His presence, joy, and peace. (Isaiah 55:8, 9, 12¹⁹)
- 5. All the pleasures associated with marriage can be enjoyed without guilt while following God's plan. (Hebrews 13:14²⁰)
- 6. A meat diet was first allowed by God when Noah and his family got off the ark after the flood. (Genesis 9:3²²)
- 7. As in marriage God has given us wisdom and council in regards to our diet. In both the Old and New Testaments God directed His true followers not to eat blood. (Leviticus 3:17²⁷; Acts 15:20²⁸)
- 8. With that caveat, man was allowed to eat "clean" meat. That included animals that chew the cud and have split hooves, and aquatic life with fins and scales. (Deuteronomy 14:2-4, 6²⁵, 9²⁶)
- 9. Obedience to God's dietary laws, the same observed by Jesus, have proven a great boon to man's health and relationship with God. (Deuteronomy 34:7³⁰; Daniel 1:8³⁶, 20; Exodus 15:26²⁹)
