- 1. Both Jesus and the prophetic word in the Old Testament teach, judgment, mercy, and faith are the weightier matters of the law and cannot be ignored in the lives of His people. (Matthew 23:23; Isaiah 56:1¹)
- 2. God's final act of judgment and His entire plan of salvation, (His plan to rid the world of sin) is clearly seen in the earthly sanctuary. (Daniel 8:14²; John 5:39³; Psalm 77:13⁴)
- 3. Mirroring the Sanctuary furnishings and services, Jesus is our sacrifice, our living water of life, our light, our living bread, and our intercessor. (Exodus 38:1 & John 1:29; Exodus 30:18 & John 7:37; Exodus 25:31, 36⁸ & John 8:12⁹; Exodus 25:30¹² & John 6:51¹³; Exodus 30:1 & Hebrews 7:25¹⁵)
- 4. The key purpose of the tabernacle or sanctuary was so God could dwell with man, and that is still His desire, to be with us and in us! (Exodus 25:8⁵; 2 Corinthians 6:16⁷; Romans 8:11)
- 5. Once a year, on the day of Atonement, the High Priest went into the most holy place and stood before the Ark of the Covenant. This was a type of the great judgment when God's mercy and law finish their work of making an end of sin. (Leviticus 16:16¹⁷)
- 6. According to the longest time prophecy this great judgment commenced in 1844. Thus we are now living in the time of the final judgment. (Daniel 8:14¹⁶; Revelation 14:6, 7)
- **Choices:** Christ was your substitute on the cross. Now He wants to be your High Priest in the Heavenly Sanctuary. Will you choose to allow His sacrifice to win your heart making it obedient to His love, and will you choose to ask Him to be your Intercessor in the final judgement that is going on right now? _____
