Thunder: QuestLine began the year with 26 slots available for filming pastors for insertion into *Thunder*. This year we have filmed two pastors, one from Arkansas and one from Saskatchewan, Canada, and we are talking with others about insertion.

It is not just pastors who are scheduling insertions. recently we received a call from an individual desiring to insert laypeople. How thrilling to see God's people catching the vision!

When we initially produced *Thunder in the Holy Land* with Charles Byrd as the host, we wondered if we were being overly ambitious ordering 1,500 sets of DVDs. Today, we have a little more than 50 sets left and have begun the process of creating a second edition of DVDs with some extra features, including closed captioning for our hearing impaired friends.

I Met God: January began our first real start on the new series. The QLP writing team took about 10 days in the Cumberland Plateau area of TN to focus on the titles, topics, and actual scripts for the new series. This process was bathed in prayer as the direction of the series was discussed and established.

Some of the areas which needed to be covered were beyond the writing team's realm of expertise and that too become the subject of prayer. On Sabbath, God led the team to Dr Franklin Cobos II, who does have extensive expertise in the very areas needed. With a heart for ministry, he graciously agreed to help us with the script writing process.

Israel Tour: While its true, the Holy Land isn't so "holy" any more, there is a depth of understanding and beauty of truth to be gained from experiencing the places we read about in Scripture.

Standing on Mt. Carmel where Elijah faced-off with the prophets of Baal, or sailing on the sea of Galilee that smoothed to a glassy calm at a whisper from Christ, brings the Bible to life in an entirely new way.

Many have asked us to lead an Israel tour, and we are getting ready to do just that. We are currently working on the details. We want this to be more than just a typical tour, we want this to be a spiritually enriching experience.
