simply stewards, “He would teach [us] ... when to sell, and how much to sell.”

The realtor said our property was worth \$250,000 more than the 2017 purchase price. So, I put God to the test. I raised that figure another 10% and told God that I didn't NEED to move as I was already serving him as the Senior Pastor of the Grants Pass District. However, if it was His timing for us to sell our home, I would commit the funds realized above the original purchase price towards the building of a studio for the *I Met God* project. After just three days and five showings we had a full price, no contingency offer.

Now we knew we were to move forward with the new studio for *I Met God*, a video Bible study for the languages of the world, but where was that studio to be located? God began pointing the direction of that move when The Park Woods Group offered to donate five prime acres just outside Cleveland, TN. But, was that where God wanted the studio? Not wanting to leave our congregations we prayerfully explored local options and watched for Gods guiding hand. Then a week before we had to be out of our home, in ONE DAY the doors closed to the local possibility, an offer came to cover our entire move to Tennessee and a 100 year old farmhouse, close to the donated property, came up for rent and was secured for us. God's directing hand was unmistakable!

So in September we said a very sad goodbye to our two church families. We obeyed God's call to help take His Gospel to the entire World and moved our downsized belongings and the QuestLine Productions ministry to Cleveland, Tennessee. God affirmed our move in several ways. Once in Tennessee Bake Crafters generously offered us free office space until our new facility is built. God then provided us a climate-

controlled storage for our ministry when none seemed to be available, and then freely supplied us the use of another storage shed adjacent to the property where we'll be building.

Some people have expressed feeling sorry for us, what with leaving the comfort of a very nice home, going through the stress of moving, stepping into a situation where I have no salary, no more retirement contributions, or medical insurance. Sounds to some like a bit of a come down, a sacrifice. But inspiration tells us, “*Human beings have no right to think that there is a limit to the efforts that they are to make in the work of soul-saving.*” (9T 32.2)

Our precious Jesus gave up far more than we'll ever give up. He sacrificed far more than we've ever had to let go of. Far from feeling like we've lost anything, we're excited! By following His example, we get a front row seat, seeing God at work, watching His mighty hand personally. God is moving His people forward toward His promised land. No “sacrifice” is too great because compared to what He's preparing, nothing we leave behind is actually a sacrifice.

God made it clear to Karen and I, that He was calling us to move, to move forward, to move out in faith. Now, as He leads us farther into His great harvest field and on into His heavenly Canaan I'd like to invite you to join us. Your “sacrifice” may not be giving up your home and comfortable source of income. But every gift and every prayer, every sacrifice you make, will propel the body of Christ forward in fulfilling the great

commission our Savior has assigned to each of us. Let's watch and work with Him, as these final movements will be rapid ones. Watch for the blessings.

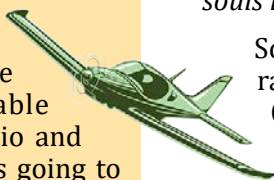
Ask & Receive

One year ago this column of the newsletter mentioned that funds were coming available to build a studio and that studio was going to need a place to land. QuestLine Productions was looking for approximately 5 acres in a more rural setting. The article also said we we're praying for a view.

Now let's be clear, a view is a desire, not a need. But God does care about our desires (Psa 37:4). He cares even more for our needs when we are working for His cause of soul saving. Hudson Taylor, missionary to China said, "God's work, done in God's way, will never lack His supply." He could say that with confidence for in Luke 11:9 Jesus Himself said, "Ask, and it shall be given you; seek, and ye shall find; knock, and it shall be opened unto you."

This donated land and these donated funds were given to move the great commission forward and to encourage us that He is still at the helm of His work. Our Father does not lack the means for He has entrusted us with them to use at His discretion.

under God, upon the reflex influence of the evangelical work done in countries afar off. It is in working actively to supply the necessities of the cause of God that we bring our souls in touch with the Source of all power. (6T 27.4, 5)

So the Grants Pass Church voted to engage in World Missions on three fronts. To raise \$6,000 to help Adventist World Radio supply God Pods for Papua New Guinea. To raise \$10,000 to build a school in India. And, with no stated goal, to support *I Met God*. In less than a year they raised \$8,000 for God Pods, \$12,000 for the school, and \$35,000 for *I Met God*!

True to God's prophecy, the church also ended with the yearly church budget in the black by \$14,000. Our school also ended in the black. Perhaps your church would like to follow the Grants Pass example? And I'm sure this "reflex influence" would also work on a personal level as well.

In 2021 The Grants Pass Church renewed their energy and commitment, funding four more World Mission projects including *I Met God*. Through the sacrifice of the Grants Pass Church members and many of our faithful donors, QLP has now received over \$187,000 since January 2020. And there's more! One of our donors has stepped up and is **matching every dollar given up to \$75,000**. What a gift and what an example! Join us in making God's Great Commission your opportunity to see Him do great things. Let this Holiday Season be a time we remember to gift Christ our love, and our hearts, by working with Him to hasten His return. **Onward!**
